

ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 69 OF SHENANDOAH, IOWA, CITY ORDINANCE AS AMENDED IN ORDINANCE NO. 2007-01

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Shenandoah, Iowa:

Section 1. Ordinance 2007-01 is amended in part and replaced in part with the following:

69.14 is amended by the removal of the paragraph that reads-

“Secondary snow emergency routes” are streets which provide access to primary snow emergency routes and are frequently used by emergency vehicles.

69.15 is amended by the addition of a paragraph that reads-

Parking is allowed on Sheridan from Railroad to Sycamore; Maple from Sheridan to Thomas; Elm from Valley to 5th; Blossom from Valley to Thomas from 5 a.m. to 11 p.m. during Snow Emergency once snow has been piled in parking area. No Parking in those areas from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. during Snow Emergency.

69.16 is amended by the removal thereof.

69.17 is amended by the removal of paragraph A, B, and C and the replacement thereof with the following:

North-South oriented Streets- Park on West side on even numbered days; park on East side on odd numbered days.

East-West oriented Streets- Park on the North side on even numbered days; park on the South side on odd numbered days.

All other streets- Park on even street number side on even numbered days; park on odd street number side on odd numbered days.

69.18 is amended by the removal of any reference to secondary snow routes.

69.19 is amended by the removal of those words and lines describing specifically what each announcement will include and where the announcement will be made with reference to secondary snow emergency route eliminated.

69.22 is amended by the removal of any reference to secondary snow emergency route.

69.23 is amended by the removal of any reference to secondary snow emergency route.

69.25 part A is amended by addition of the list of Snow Emergency Routes to include the following:

- Mustang Drive
- Matthew
- Church
- East Thomas (already have West)
- East Washington
- Tennis Court Road

69.25 part B is amended by the removal thereof.

69.26 In the course of snow removal operations the Street Department Head will have the authority to temporarily close streets for the removal of the snow to ensure the safety of those conducting operations. Any temporary closures will be announced via local and social media with as much advance warning as practical. Temporary road closures will be delineated by cones, barricades, or other means as necessary. The fine for violating the temporary closures for snow removal will be \$250.00 per occurrence and shall be subject to the same rules and enforcement as a snow emergency parking ticket.

Iowa Code 321.260

All portions of Ordinance 2007-01 not specifically amended or removed shall remain in full force.

Section 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
