

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01

**AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING NON-IOWA RESIDENTS TO BE HIRED AND
EMPLOYED AS PART TIME AND RESERVE OFFICERS FOR THE CITY OF
SHENANDOAH, IOWA**

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Shenandoah, Iowa:

AN ORDINANCE to eliminate the residency requirement for the Shenandoah Police Department and employees. This ordinance applies only to Part Time and Reserve Officer personnel.


SECTION 1- PURPOSE, the purpose of this ordinance is to eliminate the state residency requirement for Shenandoah Police Department Part Time and Reserve Officers as required by the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, Iowa Administrative Code 501-2 (1).

SECTION 2- RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT ELIMINATED. As of the effective date of the ordinance, Shenandoah Police Department Part Time and Reserve Officers will no longer be required to be residents of the State of Iowa.

SECTION 3- TIME AND DISTANCE REQUIREMENTS. The Shenandoah Police Department shall assess the needs and demands of their department and shall establish a time and distance policy for the employees of their department.


SECTION 4- EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
